1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1 This tournament applies TSF chess tournament rules, application guidelines and FIDE chess rules.

2. PARTICIPATION AND APPLICATION

- 2.1 OSTİM Technical University students and employees can participate in the tournament.
2.2 Applications can be done from “<https://form.jotform.com/240491479518061>” online address or can be done personally from unit of Ostim Teknik Üniversitesi Sağlık Kültür ve Spor Müdürlüğü which located in 3rd floor in the university.
2.3 In applications; The athlete's full name, surname, department, student number and telephone number must be included. Applicants are responsible for any loss of rights resulting from late registration or incomplete information.
2.4 All athletes must complete the registration check process before the Technical Meeting by presenting their student IDs or staff IDs.
2.5 First Round pairings will be made according to the specified schedule. Athletes who arrive after the registration control period will be subject to UKD etc. It is added to the first round pairings without discrimination, by adding them to the end of the list.
2.6 Athletes arriving after the first round has started will be taken to the next round. Before the second round, the rankings are renewed and the second round pairings are made. After the second round pairing is announced, no new athletes will be accepted into the competition.

3. TIEBREAK

- 3.1 In the Swiss System, if the degrees are shared with equal points, respectively: Buchholz-1 (from bottom) [37], Sonneborn- Berger [52], Bucholz Bucholzu [70], Match Between [11], Number of Wins [68] and Draw equality distortion methods are applied.
3.2 In the Berger System, if the degrees are shared with equal points, respectively; Match Between [11], Sonneborn-Berger [52], Number of Wins [68], and Draw tiebreaker methods are applied.

4. REWARDS

- 4.1 Medals will be given to the athletes who achieve the first three places in the general category, a cup and chess set will be given to the athlete who comes first in the general category, a chess set will be given to the athlete who comes first in the women's category, and medals will be given to the three female athletes who achieve the first tree place.
4.2 Athletes who are excluded from the tournament or lose by default in the last round cannot claim rights.
4.3 Unless the tournament director decides otherwise, athletes who do not attend the award ceremony cannot claim rights.
4.4 Athletes receive all the rewards they deserve.

5. OBJECTIONS

- 5.1 An appeal committee will not be established. The chief referee's decision is final.
5.2 Objections must be made in writing to the Head Referee no later than 10 (ten) minutes after the end of the round in which the match in question is played.

6. BİLDİRİM

- 6.1 Swiss Manager Unicode software will be used in pairing.
6.2 In accordance with FIDE Chess Rules 6.7.1, the forfeit period in the tournament is determined as 5 (five) minutes.
6.3 FIDE Chess Rules 9.1.2 applies. FIDE Rapid Chess Rules Annex A-4 applies.
6.4 According to FIDE Chess Rules 11.3.2.1 and 11.3.2.2; During a game, a player is prohibited from having a mobile phone, electronic communications device, or any device that could suggest chess moves on the playing field. If it is obvious/obvious that he/she has such a device on the playing field, the player in question will lose the game. His opponent will win.

- 6.5 The Referee is authorized to change the number of rounds, the program and the pairing system according to the number of participants; Such a possible change is announced at the Technical Meeting.
- 6.6 All pairings and results will be announced on the boards in the competition hall.
- 6.7 The "Maximum Rating" system will be applied in the starting rankings of the tournament. Maximum Rating is the ranking system that takes into account the athlete's highest score in the ELO and UKD lists in the starting rankings.
- 6.8 The current ELO/UKD list will be used in the tournament.
- 6.9All participants are deemed to have read and agreed to comply with these instructions.
