Course Objective

The aims of the course are; to provide students with basic information about Turkish Commercial Law. The course consists of theoretical topics such as the basics of law, introduction to Turkish Commercial Law, commercial enterprise in Turkish Commercial Law, commercial matters, commercial provisions, commercial litigation, traders and assistants of traders, commercial books, commercial registry, commercial name, trademarks investment, intellectual property and patent rights, unfair competition, commercial companies, company merger and takeover, outbound acquisitions of Turkish companies, commercial papers, a brief introduction to commercial maritime law. Within the scope of the course, experts in their fields will be hosted as guests and transfer their experiences to students with seminars.

Learning Outcomes

The students who succeeded in this course will be able;

- To master the basic concepts of commercial law,
- To explain the general concept of Turkish law system,
- To comprehend the place and importance of commercial law/adaptation of companies to commercial law,
- To learn the rules, concept and details of commercial law and how they affect the companies,
- To recognize the institutions/organizations that regulate commercial law and know what they do,
- To learn the details of competition, mergers, takeovers of the companies,
- To learn the basic concepts of legal/official company books, papers and other legal needs.

Course Outline

In this course; First, the definitions and basic concepts of Turkish law system in general and the Turkish commercial law, the sources of regulations will be taught and thus the importance of commercial law will be understood. Then, the basic concepts and context of the Turkish Commercial law, commercial restrictions and rules, the commercial institutions and organizations that regulate the Turkish commercial law and what they do will be explained. After the midterm exam, intellectual property and patent rights, unfair competition, commercial companies, merger and takeover, commercial papers and a brief introduction to commercial maritime law will be given to the attendees. In the week before the exams, experienced guests from the commercial law will share their experiences.
