Course Objective

The aim of the course is to provide students with basic information about Turkish Commercial Law. The course consists of theoretical topics such as the basics of law, introduction to Turkish Commercial Law, commercial enterprise in Turkish Commercial Law, commercial matters, commercial provisions, commercial litigation, traders and assistants of traders, commercial books, commercial registry, commercial name, trademarks investment, intellectual property and patent rights, unfair competition, commercial companies, company merger and takeover, outbound acquisitions of Turkish companies, commercial papers and a brief introduction to commercial maritime law.

Learning Outcomes

The students who succeeded in this course will be able;

• To explain the general concept of Turkish law system

• To master the basic concepts of commercial law,

- To comprehend the place and importance of commercial law/adaptation of companies to commercial law,
- To learn the rules, concept and details of commercial law and how they affect the companies,
- To learn the details of competition, mergers and takeovers of the companies,

• To recognize the basic concepts of legal/official company books, papers and other legal needs.

Course Outline

This course firstly gives the basic definitions, sources and concepts of Turkish law system in general. Then, the course carefully cover the concepts of the Turkish Commercial Law, commercial enterprises and commercial matters, commercial provisions and litigation, traders, commercial books, intellectual property and patent rights, unfair competition, commercial



companies, merger and takeover and also commercial papers. The course will also mention commercial maritime law briefly.

The written exams can be of two types, ie. open-ended questions, which can also be in the form of problems or multiple-choice questions. The case could also be carried to the Dean's Office for additional disciplinary action.

Assignments: Quizzes and Homework (Assignments) might be applicable. Scientific Research Ethics Rules are very important while preparing assignments. The students should be careful about citing any material used from outside sources and reference them appropriately.
